Welcome to Joburg

Welcome to Johannesburg, the most visited City in Africa for two consecutive years (Mastercard Global Cities Index 2013 & 2014). It is also Africa's vibrant metropolis, commercial and financial hub!

Now proudly taking its place as Africa's second largest city, Johannesburg is growing at an unprecedented rate – constantly and continuously transforming itself. It is the financial and industrial capital of South Africa, the economic powerhouse of Africa and was founded in the heyday of one of the world's biggest and richest gold rushes - earning it the name Egoli which means 'place of gold'.

A versatile business and mega-events destination, Johannesburg is capable of handling a vast array of events - from small meetings to massive international gatherings, conventions, concerts, sports tournaments and mega-events.

With excellent infrastructure, unique transport features, world-class hotel inventory, spectacular stadiums and magnificent architecture, it's no wonder that Johannesburg was voted the world's 3rd best city in 2011.

Did you know?

Facts

1 Johannesburg enjoys plenty of sunshine (an average of 12 hours per day) and very little wind.

2 The greater Johannesburg metropolis covers an area of 2 300 square kilometres, making it larger than Sydney, London and New York – and similar in size to Los Angeles.

3 The city is home to 60% of South Africa's information communication technology enterprises. Johannesburg hosted the International Broadcast Centre during the 2010 Soccer World Cup.

4 Johannesburg is home to 4.4 million people, the majority of whom are aged between 19 and 39.

5 Johannesburg's nickname "Egoli" means "place of gold". Forty percent of the world's gold has been found in the Witwatersrand, the reef on which the city was built.

6 Founded more than 125 years ago in 1886, Johannesburg is one of the world's youngest major cities – and the only one not founded on a major waterway (bay or large river).

7 During this time, it has been rebuilt four times – it started out as a tented mining camp, evolved into a town of tin shanties, then a city of four-storey Edwardian brick buildings and finally a city of modern skyscrapers.

8 There are 10 million trees in Johannesburg, making it the world's largest man-made, urban forest.

9 There are 17 nature reserves in the City.

10 There are 12 river systems running throughout the City.

11 Johannesburg has approximately 150 heritage sites, half of which are national monuments.

12 An amazing 40 percent of all the world's human ancestor fossils have been found in areas close to Johannesburg.

13 Johannesburg is home to the only two polar bears in Africa, at the Johannesburg Zoo.

14 There are 64 hectares of bird sanctuaries in and around Johannesburg.

15 There are 1000 ha of green spaces in and around Johannesburg. The Botanical Gardens in Emmarentia are 81 ha in size.

There are over 12,488 graded hotel rooms in Johannesburg, all catering for a variety of budgets.

VENUES

The Sandton Convention Centre provides over 22 000 m² of meeting and exhibition space. Gallagher Estate Convention Centre can host up to 12,000 delegates. The Johannesburg Expo Centre has 42 000 m² of mainly exhibition space. The Coca Cola Dome is a multi-purpose venue with 11 000 sqm that can host a banquet of up to 5000 guests.

Joburg is geographically fairly centrally located in South Africa.

AIRPORT

The O.R. Tambo International Airport (ORTIA) in Johannesburg is the air transport hub of Southern Africa, catering for more than 17 million passengers each year. It is about 30 km from the city, servicing over 55 international airlines and numerous domestic airlines.

HIGH SPEED RAILWAY

The Gautrain speed train service travels at a maximum speed of 180 kilometers per hour linking the airport to various areas of Johannesburg in just 12 minutes.

BUSES

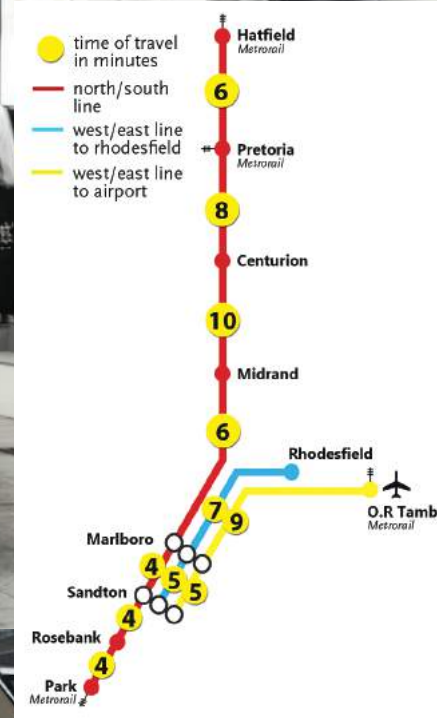
The Rea Vaya bus route covers a distance of over 120km and serves as a feeder system to the Gautrain. The bright red buses offer fast and affordable public transport throughout the city.

TAXIS

Johannesburg has two types of taxis, metered taxis and minibus taxis. Unlike other cities, metered taxis don't normally drive around the city looking for passengers, they need to be called for a pick up. Minibus taxis are largely used by locals to commute between residential areas and places of work.

THE SIGHTSEEING BUS

As with all City Sightseeing tours, Johannesburg operates on the world renowned and hugely popular Hop-On, Hop-Off, system which allows sightseers the chance to get on and off the bus at any of the 12 designated stops along the route.

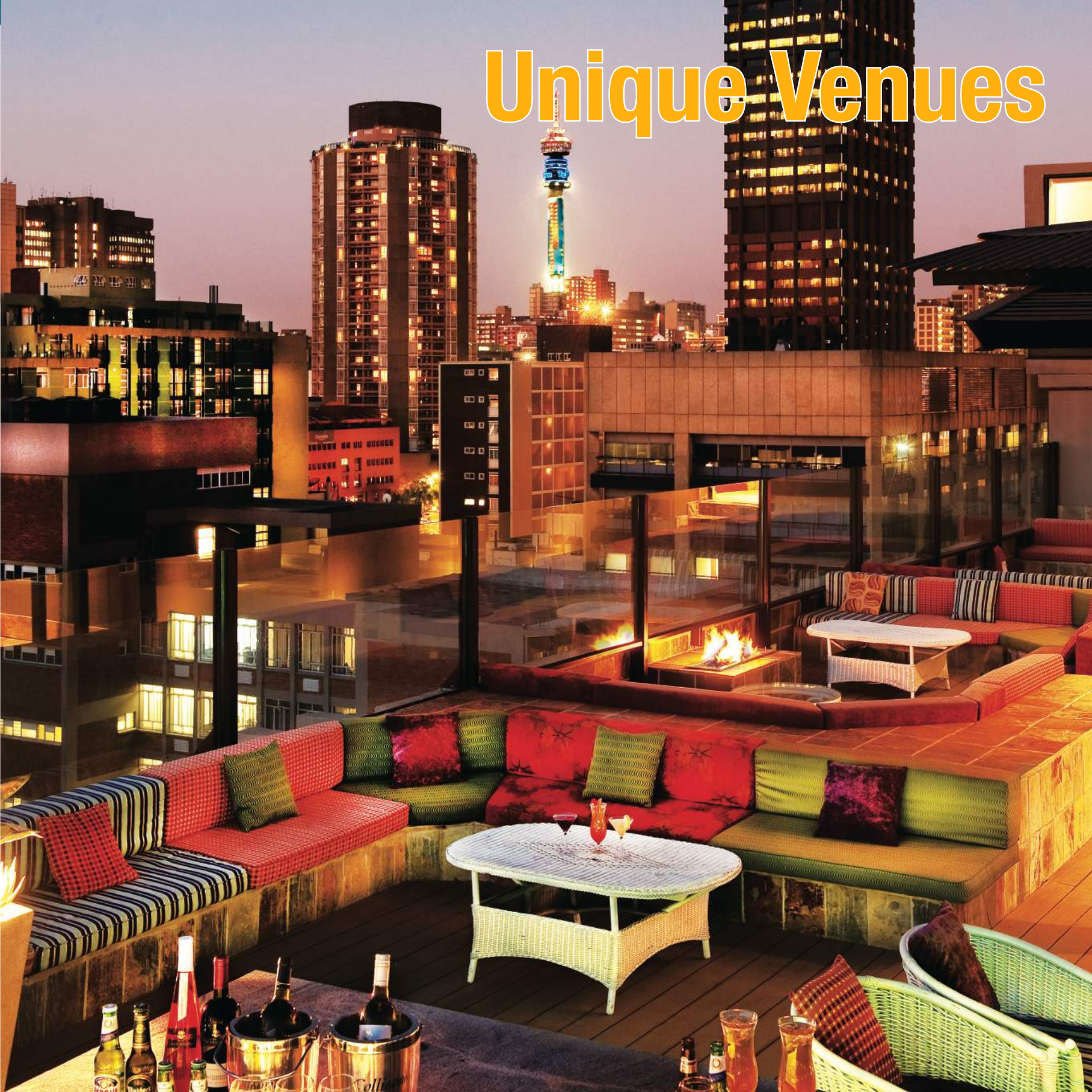

CONSTITUTION HILL

Nowhere can the story of South Africa's turbulent past and its extraordinary transition to democracy be told as it is at Constitution Hill.

Constitutional Square is an open outdoor piazza located in front of the Constitutional Court, which is the highest court in South Africa. The space is ideal for large public events and performances.

This large square is framed on two sides by the Old Fort Ramparts and on the other two sides by the double-storey facades of the Old Fort that provide excellent backdrops for staged performances. It occupies a central space within the precinct and has numerous access points and circulation thoroughfares.



The courtyards were exercise yards with two-storey high walls framing a view of the Johannesburg skyscrapers and the Hillbrow Tower. Particularly spectacular at night, the layers of history reveal themselves in the high walls that enclose the yard making it an intimate and acoustically appropriate area for small

performances and gatherings. The Slovo Courtyard is the main internal prison yard and is situated at the centre of the Old Fort. It is framed by historic walls of the Old Fort complex that offer a perfect canvas for outdoor projection. This is the very courtyard in which Joe Slovo provided legal advice to other prisoners.

The Laundry Courtyard is a large outdoor space with a view of one of the permanent exhibition spaces. Located on the west side, the Women's Gaol Lekgotla and Laundry courtyard are connected by a small central garden courtyard.

JOHANNESBURG BOTANICAL GARDENS

The Johannesburg Botanical Gardens are an inspiring mix of open spaces that includes marshland, grassland, trees and cultivated gardens.

A central and popular feature of these botanical gardens in Johannesburg is Emmarentia Dam. Built in the early 19th century, after the South African War, the dam remains popular with urban canoeists, kayakers, boating enthusiasts, casual anglers and many aquatic waterfowl.

CONSTITUTION HILL



Nowhere can the story of South Africa's turbulent past and its extraordinary transition to democracy be told as it is at Constitution Hill.

Constitutional Square is an open outdoor piazza located in front of the Constitutional Court, which is the highest court in South Africa. The space is ideal for large public events and performances.

This large square is framed on two sides by the Old Fort Ramparts and on the other two sides by the double-

storey facades of the Old Fort that provide excellent backdrops for staged performances. It occupies a central space within the precinct and has numerous access points and circulation thoroughfares.

The courtyards were exercise yards with two-storey high walls framing a view of the Johannesburg skyscrapers and the Hillbrow Tower. Particularly spectacular at night, the layers of history reveal themselves in the high walls that enclose the yard making it an intimate and acoustically appropriate area for small performances and gatherings. The Slovo Courtyard is the main internal prison yard and is situated at the centre of the Old Fort. It is framed by historic walls of the Old Fort complex that offer a perfect canvas for outdoor projection. This is the very courtyard that Joe Slovo provided legal advice to other prisoners.

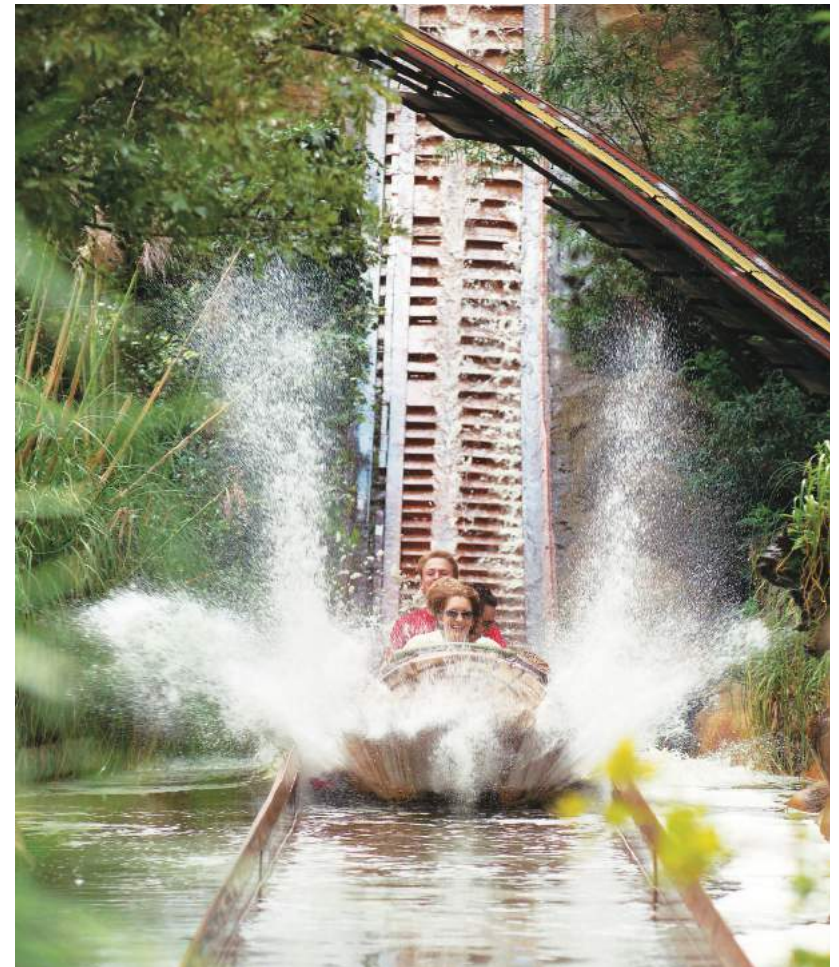

SOWETO

Soweto is an urban area of the city of Johannesburg in Gauteng, bordering the city's mining belt in the south.

The history of African townships southwest of Johannesburg that would later form Soweto was propelled by the increasing eviction of Africans by city and state authorities. Africans had been drawn to work on the gold mines that were established after 1886. From the start they were accommodated in separate areas on the outskirts of Johannesburg, such as Brickfields (Newtown). In 1904, British-controlled city authorities removed African and Indian residents of Brickfields to an "evacuation camp" at Klipspruit municipal sewage farm (not Kliptown, a separate township) outside the Johannesburg municipal boundary, following a reported outbreak of plague.

Many parts of Soweto rank among the poorest in Johannesburg, although individual townships tend to have a

WALTER SISULU BOTANICAL GARDENS

This Botanical Garden was founded in 1982, but has been a popular venue for outings since the 1800's. The garden has been voted the best place to get back to nature in Gauteng for 9 years in a row.

The natural vegetation of the area is known as the 'Rocky Highveld Grassland' and consists of a mosaic of grassland and savanna, with dense bush in kloofs and along streams. The variety of habitats accommodates over 600 naturally occurring plant species.



A breeding pair of majestic Verreaux's Eagles nest on the cliffs alongside the waterfall. The garden is home to an abundance of wildlife with over 220 birds species recorded on site. There are also a number of reptiles and small mammals, including small antelope and jackals, which occur naturally in the Nature Reserve.

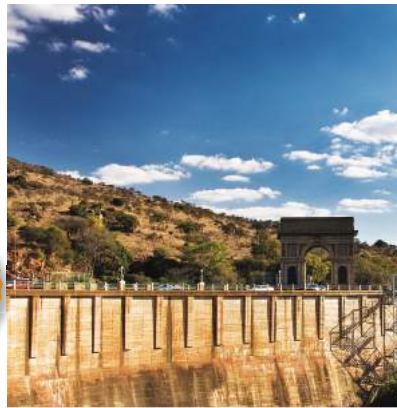

The name of the town means "gateway of the hartbees" (a species of antelope) in Afrikaans. It was previously known as Schoemansville, named after General Hendrik Schoeman, a boer general in the Anglo-Boer War who owned the farm that the Hartbeespoort Dam was built on.

The town consists mainly of holiday homes around the dam as it is popular with visitors from nearby Gauteng Province. It is home to the Om Die Dam ultra marathon of 50 km, which takes place annually in the first half of the year. The spectacular view of the Magaliesberg Mountains is breathtaking and is best savoured at sunset whilst on a leisurely boat cruise.

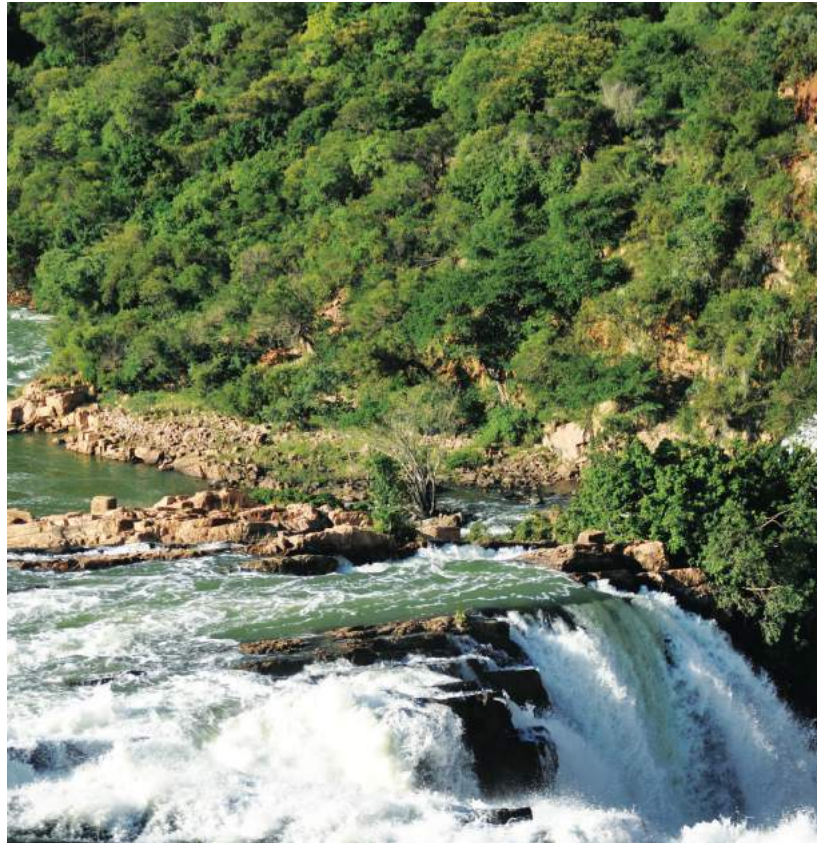

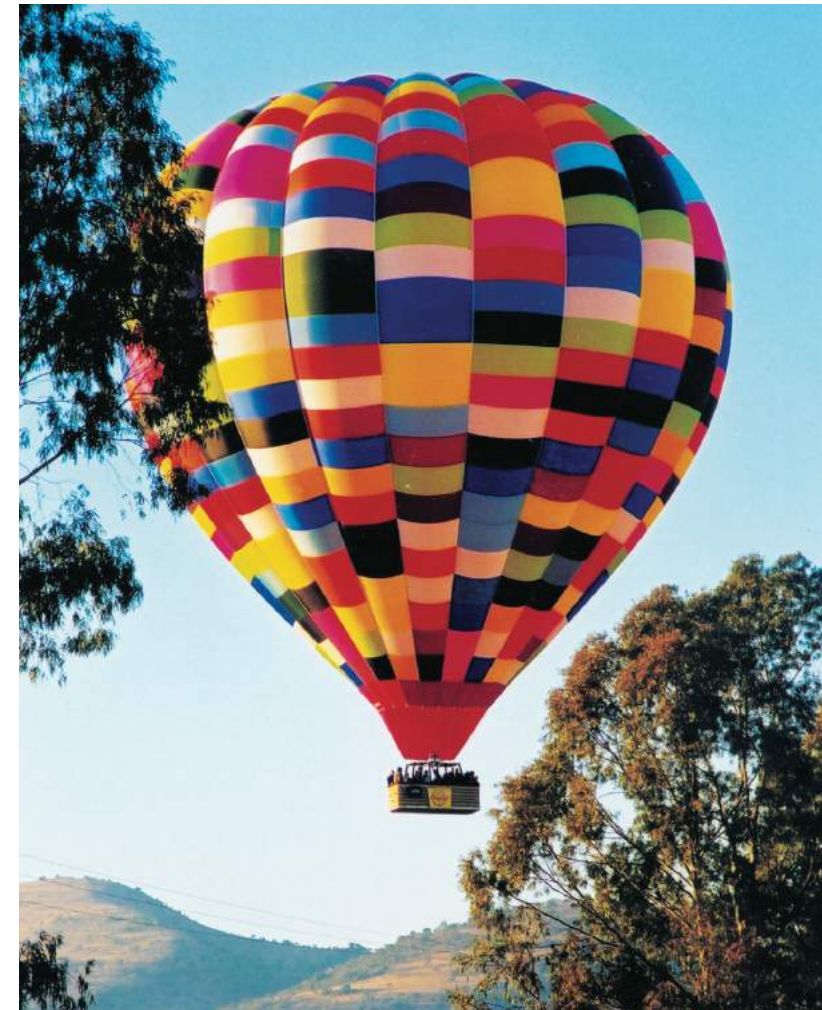

Dinokeng is a Big 5 nature reserve that lies 45 minutes northeast of Johannesburg, and a mere 15 minutes from Pretoria/Tshwane. Dinokeng is marketed as the place of the world's largest diamond, discovered because of its proximity to the Cullinan Diamond. Dinokeng refers to an area, not particular town and is also part of an initiative by the government to establish a tourist destination close to Gauteng that lies in the catchment areas of two rivers, the Elands and Pienaars. These two rivers flow into the greater Olifants and Limpopo Rivers.

The land has been home to a number of different groups over the years, and with it, a number of different cultures. The Tswana, Pedi, Afrikaans, Ndebele, English and Tsonga-speaking people have all called the area their home and have had significant effects on the land of Dinokeng. The Anglo-Boer War blockhouses, battle sites, cemeteries and forts are all evidence of the conflicts that have taken place on this unique piece of land north of Pretoria.

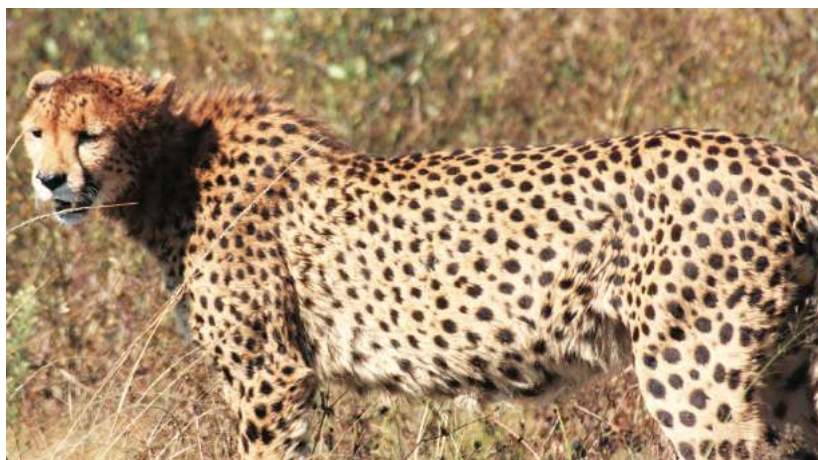
