- Nelson Mandela Bay is home to Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University with Re search units within NMMU including (Centre for Energy Research / Institute for Coastal & Marine Research / the Agricultural Research Council), other research institutes include the Council for Scientific & Industrial Re search (CSIR) / South African International Maritime Institute (SAIMI) / Bayworld / Citrus Research International (CRI) / Human Sciences Research Council (HSRC), etc.
- Nelson Mandela Bay is Home of the Big7 (Elephant, Lion, Rhino, Leopard, Buffalo, Great White Shark, Southern Right Whale)
- Route 67 ~ consists of 67 Public Art works symbolising Nelson Mandela's 67 year of work dedication to the Freedom of South Africa and included 67 steps leading up to the second largest flag in Africa. The artworks were designed by local artists from the Eastern Cape.
- Accommodation establishments include 5 star hotels, graded bed & breakfast and guest houses, self-catering units, holiday resorts, etc.
